

THE LEADERBOARD CHANGES AGAIN AS TEAM A8 TAKES (24) POINTS TO TAKE OVER 1ST PLACE AFTER WEEK 4 ~ TEAM #7 & TEAM #3 ARE TIED FOR 2ND WITH OUR FIRST POSITION ROUND COMING UP NEXT WEEK

A4: Trevor Vallus (46) / Nate Hood (48): Two holes bit into Trevor's round as he comes in with a (46), three shots worse than last week. Trevor notched pars on tough #1 an hole #8. He made bogeys on all but 2 holes. Hole #3 gouged him for a triple which was followed with a double on #4. Trevor finish with (2) pars. Good effort Trevor. Nate went up 4 strokes from last weeks round, as two triples and a double pretty much destroyed his round. Hole #1 and hole number 3 were the culprits that did the most damage, although #2 didn't help with a double. Nate posted pars on 3 and 7 and bogeyed the other 4 holes as he finished with a (48). Good try Nate.



A5: Stan Dreslinski (46) / Ray Ressler (43): Stan continues to struggle to get his round back down into the lower 40's, coming in with a (46), not great but a stroke better than the previous week. Stan nailed a par on the #1 handicap hole, but a couple of doubles hurt his chance to go lower. Hole #2 and hole #6 bit him for doubles. He finished the round posting bogeys on everything else. Stan posted (1) par in his round. Good effort Stan. Ray also fell off last weeks under 40's round, coming in with a (43). Ray posted bogeys on 7 holes, posting his only pars on #4 and #9 to finish with (2)



pars. He played steady but too many bogeys did too much damage keeping him above 40. Good try Ray.

A6: Steve Ciaramitaro (53) / Bill Gaunt (sub-Adam West) (40): Steve continues to hover in the lower 50's, trying to get his rounds down into the 40's. The problem hole became #4, as it cost him 4 extra shots over the hole par. The second problem hole was tough #6, that cost him a triple. He added four doubles to this card. He nailed a par on #7 and finished with a (53), a stroke better than last week. Nice try Steve. Bill was unable to attend and Adam West subbed for him, posting a very nice 4 over (40). For the second time subbing, Adam posts a very decent round. Adam found bogeys holes 1 & 2. After notching a par on #3, Adam added another bogey, this on #4. He got rid of the extra shot from 4 with a very nice birdie on #5. Hole #6 clipped him for his only double, and he finished strong, posting a birdie on #8 and par on #9, The shot par 3, #7 gave him his final bogey. Adam finished with (2) pars and (2) birdies.



A7: Tom Van (40) / Gary Kwapik (41): Tom has had a couple of tough weeks but turned it around in week 4. Tom comes into the clubhouse with a

nice four over round of (40). The first par 5 cost him his only double, but he did reduce the strokes from that hole with a couple of birdies. One on the par 5 - fifth hole and the final one on #9. Tom notched pars on 3 and 7 posting bogeys on the balance of the holes. Tom finished with (2) pars and (2) birdies. Good shooting Tom. Gary also had a decent round as he comes in with a (41). Gary stuck a par on #5 between bogeys on 1 & 3. He took his only double on the par 3 fourth hole and then reduce one extra shot with a birdie on #5. He finished with a bogeys on 6 & 8 and pars on 7 & 9. Gary finished with (3) pars and (1) birdie. Nice round Gary.



A8: Wayne Davidson (42) / Rusty Ellison (48): We have new leaders

after week 4, as Wayne & Rusty each take 12 points and a one point lead over two teams. Rusty struggled posting his worse round of the year coming in four shots higher than last week with a (48). The toughest hole on his card was the par 5 - 5th as he made a triple. Three doubles did not help either as he took them on #2, #8 & #9. Rusty managed back to back pars on holes #6 & #7. Rusty finished with (2) pars. Good try Rusty. Wayne comes right back after last weeks nice 42 with another (42). The 1st hole did the most damage as he got bit by a quad. He settled down after that, nailing a par on #2. After a



bogey-par-bogey run on his next three holes, Wayne played solid from that point on. He nailed four straight finish pars to out the round on a positive note. Wayne finished with (6) pars in a very nice round. Good shooting Wayne.



A9: Warren Hood (45) / Jim Turner (45): Jim played bogey golf most of his round. He started with a bogey on 1 and nailed his first of two pars on #2. He bogeyed his way to #6, where double trouble popped up. He nailed his final par on #7 and finished with his second double on #8 and bogey on 9. Jim notched (2) pars in his round of (45). 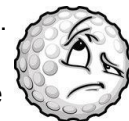
