A6: Bill Gaunt (47) / Steve Ciaramitato (57): Bill's rounds seem to be going up instead of back down. Bill comes in with a disappointing (47), two shots higher than last week. Both par 5's (2 & 5) and 3rd & 9th hole cost Bill (8) extra strokes in his round. He notched pars on 6, 7 & 8 to finish with (3). Ok, where did the real Bill Gaunt go. Good effort Bill. Steve also had his fair share of problems as he limps into the clubhouse with a (57), ten shots over last weeks round. Doubles on 1 & 2 were followed by a bogey on 3. The 4th hole cost Steve yet another double. The real problem showed up on #5 as Steve added 4 strokes over the hole par. The final four holes cost him triples on 6 & 8 and doubles on 7 & 9. A valiant effort Steve.

A7: Gary Kwapik (43) / Tom Van (44): It must have been the night, as Gary followed last weeks 38 with a (43) in week 6. Gary posted a lone double on hole #6 as he an Tom fell out of first into third after position round 1. Gary notched pars on both par 5's, and one par three to finish with (3). Bogeys filled in the rest of his score card, posting 5 of them. Good try Gary. Tom only increased his score from the previous week by 2 strokes, coming

into the watering hole with a (44). Tom posted a bogey on hole #2, nailing pars on 1 & 3. He notched his third par on hole 5, with doubles on 4 & 6. He posted one more par, this one on the par three 7th and finished with one more double and one more bogey. Tom notched (4) pars in a decent round, but tough finish. Good try Tom.

A8: Wayne Davidson (46) / Rusty Ellison (44): After a couple of weeks of lower 40's rounds, Wayne has had two in a row in the middle of the 40's as he comes in with a (46). Wayne posted 4 bogeys and par on holes 1 thru 5. He got bit by a double on #6 and a double on #9. He made bogeys on 7 & 8 finishing his round with just (1) par. Good try Wayne. Rusty continues to stay in the lower 40's as he posts a (44) in week 6. Two holes took their toll on Rusty's round that cost him a chance for a under 40 round. Hole #1 and hole #9 bit him for triples. He notched a birdie on #3 with pars on 5, 7 & 8. The rest of his card listed bogeys. Rusty finished with (3) pars and (1) birdie. Nice shooting Rusty.

A9: Warren Hood (43) / Jim Turner (sub Brian Cooper) (49): Warren brought down his round by 3 strokes from the *continued below left*

week 5 with (43). Warren put bogeys on the card for holes 1,2 & 3. He got out of the bogey rut with a par on 4 and nailed a nice birdie on #5. He made bogeys on 3 of the last four holes, making his only double on #7. Warren finished with (1) birdie to go with (1) par. Jim was absent but Brian Cooper subbed for him in week 6. Brian comes into the 19th hole with a (49). He had several rough holes in his round. Brian got stung by 5 doubles that cost his round 10 extra shots. He notched a par on 4 posting bogeys on the other 3 holes. Brian finished with (1) par. Good effort Brian.

A10: Billy Alessandrini (45) / Scott Brogdon (49): Billy posted another round in the 40's for the second week in a row. Billy shoots a (45), going up two strokes from last week. Two holes took the most toll on Billy's round, as

he posted a triple on #8 and double on #5. Billy nailed pars on hole #3, the tough #6 and the par three 7th. The other four holes were bogeys on the card. Billy finished with (3) pars. Nice round Billy. Scott asked if he could use his pre-round score instead of the one he posted in the league. Scott took a (49), 7 shots off the previous weeks round. His first three holes did not present much problems, as he posted a couple of bogeys and a par on #2. The everything went south, starting on #4 as he put a triple on his card. He made back to back doubles but looked like he might get his round back in line with a par on #7. It was not to be as holes 8 and 9 took him for back to back doubles for the second time in his round. Scott finished with (2) pars. Nice effort Scott.

A11: Pat Nellis (sub Freddie Steerzer) (39) / Cory Routheaux (sub Doug Busam) (48):

After a few weeks of tough rounds, Freddie has seemed to get into a groove. Freddie took a bogey on 1 and notched a birdie on 2. After another par, Freddie went back to back with bogeys. He finished his final four holes with three pars and a bogey. Freddie finished with (4) pars and (1) birdie. Nice round Freddie. Cory was on vacation and Doug Busam subbed for him. Doug came into the clubhouse with a (48). Holes 1 and 3 clipped him for triples, sticking in a bogey on #2. He nailed back to back pars on 4 & 5. This took him to hole # 9 where he finished his round with a bogey. Andre notched (3) pars. Good effort Andre. Dennis was absent and Dominic DeRita subbed for him. Dom put a bogey on the card on #1, but made par on #2 and birdie on #3 to get his card back to even. After the par on #4, the 2nd par 5 bit him for a double. He finished with bogey on 6, par on 7, bogey on 8 and par on 9. Good finish Dom. Dom notched (4) pars and (1) birdie.

A3: Ken Huyghe (44) / Dale Lohr (46):
Ken played bogey golf most the his round. He nailed two pars, both of them on the par 5's, #2 and #5. He posted his only double on the tough sixth hole. This gave him bogeys on
