Both players had some outstanding rounds in last weeks play. Gary only had one major problem on his card that took place on #5. He posted his only double. He notched (4) pars enroute to his four over par round of (40). He nailed a birdie on #1 and the rest of the holes were bogeys. Nice round Gary. Tom also found some trouble on #5, that clipped him for his only double. Tom played steady posting pars on 5 of the 9 holes. Tom nailed a birdie on #9 as he drove over the water and left himself a 30 yard chip that nestled close enough to award him a birdie. Tom finished with a very nice three over par (39). It will be each two man league team trying to score points by making Hole in Ones, Double Eagles, Eagles, Birdies, Pars and Bogeys. This will be a scramble using the team's best shot on each turn. This is not a handicapped round. Shoot your best and tally the points based on the following scoring format.

HOLE IN ONES : Will earn 6 points

DOUBLE EAGLES: Will earn 5 points

EAGLES: Will earn 4 points

BIRDIES: Will earn 3 Points

PARS: Will earn 2 points

BOGEYS: Will earn 1 point

Example: Brian & Brent:

Hole 1- Birdie (3 points),

Hole 2-Par (2 points),

Hole 3-Birdie (3 points),

Hole 4-Bogey (1 point),

Hole 5-Birdie (3 points),

Hole 6-par (2 points),

Hole 7-par (2 points),

Hole 8-par (2 points),

Hole 9-Eagle (4 points).

Brian & Brent would add (22) points to their total points in the standings.

The points won will be added to the teams point totals. This round will not be used in calculation of your handicap.
