B9: Greg Haigh (45) / Mike Kove (56) : Greg continues to hover in the mid forties, coming into the watering hole with a (45). Greg nailed pars on 10, 15, 17 to help his round. He got bit by a triple on 11 and doubles on 12 & 18. All in all a decent round. Nice job Greg. Mike continues his seesaw rounds. This week in the mid 50's as he posts a (56). Hole 10 did quad damage and hole 18, 12, & 15 clipped him for a triples. Most of the other holes were doubles, except for 16 and 17 where he made bogeys. Good try Mike.

B1: Ken Kelchner (45) / Denny Obenauer (54): Ken nailed pars on 10 & 11 and put a bogey on the card on #12. Holes 13, 14 & 15 did the most damage, He made doubles on 13 & 15 sticking in a triple on #14. He managed one more par in his round, this one on #16. Ken finished with (3) pars. Good effort Ken. Denny's round went up 4 strokes from last week, posting a (54) in his round. Denny got bit by doubles on 10, 13, 14, 16 & 17. The 11th hole gouged him for a quad and the final hole got him for a triple. A valiant effort Denny.

B2: Steve Miramonti (46) / Kurt Lorenger (abs): Kurt continues to get stuck working and was unable to make it last week. Steve comes into the clubhouse with his second (46) in a row. Steve played bogey golf on 10 & 11 and nailed a

par on #12. After a bogey on 13, Steve was saddled with back to back doubles. He managed bogeys on 16 & 18 and stuck in a double on 17. Steve finished with (1) par. Good effort Steve.

B3: Ernie Danos (50) / Steve Fleck (60): Both Ernie and Steve had troubles playing against the course. Ernie came in 3 shots higher than last week, posting a (50). Ernie started with back to back doubles, and then looked like he got his round back under control with back to back bogeys. Hole # 14 stung him with another double and #15 clipped him for a triple. He nailed a par on 16 and finished with back to back doubles. Steve opened with quads on 10 & 11 to get off to a poor start. It didn't get much better as he posted triples on the next 3 holes. He finished with doubles on the final four holes. A valiant try Steve.

B4: Larry Ball (52) / Norm Giraud (54): Larry seemed to get on a double bogey run that took his round down. Hole 10 got him for his first double. He bogeyed 11 and nailed his only par on 12. Larry then posted doubles on 5 of the next six holes

Three triples crippled his round starting on #10. He added two more 13 & 14. The balance of the holes showed up as doubles. He did manage bogeys on 12 & tough #17. Good try Norm.

B5: Ron Corfield (60) / Erv Rock (58): Ron shaved off three strokes from last week, posting a (60) in his round. Ron found a triple and quad on 10 & 13, with double bogeys in between. The doubles continued to show up on the card for the next three holes. The final two holes did the balance of damage with 5 extra shots on 17 and a triple on 18. Good try Ron. Erv stayed in the upper 50's as he comes in with a

(58) in last weeks round. Hole 10 cost Erv a quad to start and he managed to post a double on 11. After the bogey on 12, things went south again. Erv took back to back doubles on 13 & 14. After a couple more doubles, Erv nailed a par on the hardest handicap hole on the back, #17. The final hole bit into his round with a triple. Erv finished with (1) par. A valiant effort Erv.

Back to back pars on 11 & 12, then a short stop with a bogey on 13. He nailed a birdie on 15 with pars on 14, 16 & 18. He made his second bogey on 17. Nice round Ken. Ken notched (5) pars and (1) birdie. Ben Newman subbed for Dale Lohr and comes in with the same score as Ken, a 3 over (38). Ben put bogeys on the card for 10 and 17. He got stung by a double on 13. He nailed a birdie on 14 and posted pars on the other 5 holes. Nice round Ben. Ben finished with (5) pars and (1) birdie.

A4: Nate Hood (sub Tom Marshall) (47) / Trevor Vallus

(sub Brian Cooper) (41): Tom, subbing for Nate, has struggled a bit, but put together a better round subbing this week. He comes into the clubhouse with a (47). Tom took bogeys on 10, 12 & 13 and stuck in a triple on 11. He nailed back to back pars on 14 & 15 and then put a bogey on the card on 16. The final two holes did his round in with a 2nd triple, this one on 17 and a double on the par 5 - 18th. Still a much better round Tom. Tom posted (2) pars. Brian had an absolutely very nice round coming in with his best as a sub so far, posting a 5 over (41). Brian had two tough holes in his round. He bogeyed 10 and then notched three straight pars. Hole 14 cost him a chance to go under 40 as he posted a triple. He got back on a roll posting three more pars that took him to the 18 where he finished with a double. Brian finished with (6) pars.
