B1: Ken Kelchner (46) / Denny Obenauer (45): Ken had a couple of tough holes, posting 2 doubles in his round. He took one on #3 and the second double on #8. He nailed his only par on #4. Ken finished with a (46), a little higher than his average score. Good try Ken. Denny has been trying to get back into the 40's for four weeks and finally succeeded as he posts a nice (45). Denny had three bad holes, two were doubles and (1) was a triple. He put the triple on the card on hole #6. Doubles were listed on holes 3 & 8. Denny nailed four pars enroute to his mid forties round. He posted them on 4 & 5, then on 7 & 9. Good shooting Denny.

B2: Steve Miramonti (41) / Kurt Lorenger (47): Steve continues to play well and comes in with the best score in the 'B' flight with a 5 over (41). Steve got bit by one double, posting that on hole #3. Steve nailed pars on 4 of the first 5 holes to jump

start a nice round. He finished with (1) more par, along with 3 bogeys. Very nice shooting Steve. Steve posted (5) pars. Kurt nailed a par on the tough #1 handicap hole on the front, #1. He then jumped on the bogey train for three holes before stopping that with a par on #5. After a bogey on 6, the bottom dropped out. Kurt took a double on 7, followed by a triple on 8 and final double on 9. Good effort Kurt. Kurt notched (2) pars.

B3: Ernie Danos (47) / Steve Fleck (62): After a week in the fifties, Ernie dropped back into the 40's, posting a (47) last week. The #1 handicap hole was his worse hole, as he got stung by a triple.
