Tom loaded bogeys on the card on #1 & #2 and then got tripped up by a double on 13. He again posted bogeys on the next three holes before stopping them with a birdie on #7. One more bogey and a final birdie on #9. Tom posted no birdies in his round, but he did manage two birdies. Good round Tom.
