TEAM B7 (DAVE & JOHN) MOVE TO WITHIN A POINT OF FIRST PLACE LEADERS TEAM B9 (GREG & MIKE) WITH 5 WEEKS OF COMPETITION TO PLAY ~~~

B4: Larry Ball (47) / Norm Giraud (49): Larry comes into the 19th hole with a round of (47). Holes 10 and 11 cost him a triple followed by a double. He nailed a par on 12 and bogeyed the next two holes. Hole 15 got him for a double. One more bogey and then back to back doubles. Good round Larry. Norm posted the same two scores on 10 & 11 that his partner posted, a triple and double. He bogeyed the next three holes and doubled #15. He parred 16 and finished with doubles on the final two holes. Norm finished with a (49).

B5: Ron Corfield (sub Matt Zuber-47) /Erv Rock (61): Matt subbed for Ron who is still having some minor health issues. After a rough 1st hole, where Matt got saddled with a quad, he settled down to finish with a decent round of (47). A par on 11 was followed by a double on 12. He bogeyed the next three holes and nailed a par on 15. The double bogey on 17 was surrounded by bo-

geys on 16 & 18. Good effort Matt. Erv has been playing stellar the last several weeks, but had some troubles in last weeks round. He comes into the clubhouse with a (61) a strokes less than the previous week. Three of his first four holes produced triples. He bogeyed 12 and then 14 clipped him for a quad. One more triple, this on #15 and a bogey on 16. He finished on a sour note, with back to back quads. Good try Erv.

B6: Bill Folson (sub Nick Fleece-58) / Dino DeTomaso (abs): Dino was absent for the 4th straight week and Bill Folson is still healing from the Rotator Cuff problem. Nick Fleece subbed for Bill and comes in with a disappointing (58). Nick was struggling with a neck issue and paid the price in his round. #10 got him for 6 extra shots. After a bogey on 11, Nick stuck the green for closest to the pin and picked up a par. After a quad on 13, Nick added back to back doubles. A quad on 17 and finished with a triple on 18. A valiant effort Nick.

B7: Dave Maxon (50) / John Wegrzyn (45): Dave & John inch closer to the top, taking 2 more points than the leaders and now trail by 1 point. Dave posted two triples on the card, one on 10 and the other on 14. He put doubles on the card on 11, 12 & 13 and 15 before stopping them with a par on 16. He finished with a double on 17 and bogey on 18. Nice try Dave. John dropped off a stroke from last week coming in with a (45). John got started with a bogey by got tripped up on #11 with a double. A par on 12 was followed by a bogey on 13. John doubled 14 and then bogeyed his way thru the next four holes. Good finish John.

B8: Walter Wnuk (54) / Paul McWhinnie (49): Walter posts his best round of the league, coming in with a (54). Walter took a triple on 10 and double on 11 and then notched a bogey on 12. Hole #13 cost him a quad, but he nailed

a great par on 14. He finished with a couple of bogeys, one on 16 and the other on 18. Hole 17 did the balance of damage as he added 5 extra shots on the card. Good round Walter. Paul got back into the 40's as he posts a (49) last

week. #10 got him like many others with a triple. A bogey on 11 was followed by back to back doubles. He bogeyed his way through the next two holes and then got bitten by a triple on 16. Paul finished better than he

Then he stuck a bogey on #12 between doubles on 11 & 13. He nailed the par on tough 14 and seemed to level out. He posted bogeys on 2 holes, doubled the par three 16 and finished with a par. Brian shoots a (48). Good effort Brian. Trevor shoots a (43) and played knocks off 3 strokes from last week. After a bogey on 10, Trevor took a double on 11. He nailed a
