Greg bogeyed most of the holes he played, but the first two holes and the last hole did the damage. He posted a quad on 1, double on 2 and triple on 9. Greg posted a par on #7. After 4 weeks in the 50's, Mike got his round

back into the 40's as he comes in with a (48). Mike took doubles on 1 & 2 and then got into bogeys on his next three holes. One more double and then bogeys the rest of the way out. Good shooting Mike.

B1: Ken Kelchner (45) / Sub Tom Marshall (47):

Ken continues to shoot in the mid 40's as he posts a round of (45). Ken Had a few tough holes, posting a double on 1 and triple on 6.
