B1: Dave / John:

Dave still struggling a bit, posts a (51), one worse than last week. Dave posted (1) par in his round. John dropped off 7 strokes coming in with a (48). John posted (1) par in his round,

B2: Larry / Norm:

Larry dropped off 6 strokes off last weeks round coming in with a (48). Larry nailed a birdie on hole #9.

Norm finished his round with the same score as last week, posting a (55). Norm nailed (2) pars, one coming on the #2 par 5.

B3: Dale / Shane:

Dale had (4) pars and was on pace for a decent round till back to back holes cost him 8 extra strokes. Dale finished with a (54).

Shane turned in a nice (47). Shane nailed (4) pars as well. Shane is steadily lowering his handicap.

B4: Don / Brandon:

Don continues to shoot decent as he comes in with the best round in the 'B' Flight, posting a (44). Don notched (2) pars in his round. Partner Brandon knocked off 7 strokes from last week, coming in with a (51).

B5: Ernie / Steve F:

Ernie went up a couple of strokes as he comes into the clubhouse with a (50). Ernie nailed back to back pars on 3 & 4 but nothing else came together. He finished with the (2) pars. Steve knocked off a stroke from last week as he comes in with a (61). Holes 3, 4, 5 & 6 cost Steve an extra 16 shots that elevated his round total.

B6: Mike / Bob:

Mike shot the same score as he did last week, coming in with a (59). Mike had a couple of tough holes but did nail a par on hole #7. Bob went up three strokes from last weeks round. Bob struggled most of his round and looks to rebound in week 3.

B7: Ron / Ryan:

Ron knocked off 12 strokes from his first weeks match. Ron seemed to have a few

tough holes that elevated his score. He is on his way to possible knocking off more strokes this coming week. Ron finished with a (62). Ryan likewise reduced his last weeks round by 5 strokes coming in with a (57). Ryan nailed a par on the #1 handicap hole, and was the only par he had in his round. Holes 5 & 6 took the most toll on his round.

B8: Cory / Wyatt:

Cory is still trying to find his game. He comes into the 19th hole with a (51). He went up 4 strokes from last week. His card was filled with 6 doubles. Wyatt took a couple strokes off last weeks round, posting a (53). The final two holes did triple damage to his round that cost him a better round.

Ray reduced his strokes from last week by one posting a (44). Ray notched (3) pars and the hole that cost him extra was #8, where he posted a triple.

A5: Andre / Dennis:

Andre also struggled a bit, coming into the clubhouse with a (44) four strokes up from last week. Andre got bit by a triple on hole 6, and posted bogeys on 5, notching pars on (3) holes. Dennis had an "I want to forget about this one" round as he came in with one of his worse rounds, shooting a (53). Dennis got beat up by three triples that did his round in. Dennis notched (1) par.

A6: Ken / Abe:

Ken went up one stroke from last week coming in with a (41). Ken nailed (5) pars in a very nice round. Hole number 9 cost him a double. Abe went up 4

strokes from last week, coming into the watering hole with a (66). Several holes took their toll on his round with triples and quads. Abe looks to rebound with a better round in the coming weeks.

A7: Nate / Trevor:
