POSITION ROUND #1—'B' FLIGHT

1st : B3 (Dale & Shane) vs 2nd: B8 (Cory & Wyatt)

Dale played Cory and it was a back and forth battle. After the first 5 holes, both players had 5 points. Cory surged ahead of Dale with back to back wins on holes 6 & 7. Cory put a triple on the card on #8 as Dale took the hole with a double. Cory finished the round with a par and a (44) as Dale posted a bogey and loses the match, 11 points for Cory and 7 points for Dale. Dale shoots a (46). Shane played Wyatt in the other 1st and 2nd place pair-

ing. Shane posted his best round coming in with a (45) against Wyatt's (58). Shane had built up a 9 to 1 point lead after the first 5 holes. Wyatt had a few problem holes and never got into the match. Shane takes 14 points and Wyatt gets 4. Dale and Shane remain in first place with a 6 point lead over new 2nd place Team B1.

3rd : B1 (Dave & John) vs 3rd : B2 (Larry & Norm)

Larry was matched up against John and had his share of trouble holes. It was a close match

the entire round. After six holes, John had a 2 point lead over Larry. Larry overtook John with back to back hole wins thru #7. John finished off the match with back to back holes on 8 & 9 to win the match by 2 points. Larry shoots a (55) and John shoots a (47). Dave took a 3 point lead over Norm after the first 5 holes. Dave won 2 holes and tie the other three. Norm nailed a par on the 6th hole to post the only hole he would win. Dave shot a (51) taking 11 points to Norm's 7 points with his round of (55).

5th : B7 (Ron & Ryan) vs 6th : B4 (Bob G-sub for Don & Brandon)

Ron and Brandon squared off and the match ended up in a tie with both players taking 9 points. Ron took a 4 to 2 point lead after the first four holes. Too many tough holes cost Ron a chance to take more holes. Both players won three holes and tied three. Ron finished with a (65) and Brandon shot a (58). Ryan was pitted against Don Washburn's sub, Bob Gielegghem, Brandon's father, and came out on top taking 11 points

to Bob's 7. Ryan is starting to bring down his rounds and posts a nice (49), his first round in the 40's. Bob struggled a bit coming in with a (60). Ryan lost the 1st hole and then put together four straight wins to take a 8 to 2 point lead, which included a birdie nailed on #5. Bob took the tough hole #6 and then tied Ryan on hole #7. Ryan would win one more hole with Bob taking the final hole. Good shooting by both players in a tough match.

7th : B6 (Mike & Bob) vs 8th : B5 (Ernie & Steve):

Ernie was matched up against Mike and came out on top taking 13 points to Mike's 5. Ernie played a steady round coming in with a (51) as Mike had some struggles on some of the holes as he posted a (60). It was still close after the first 6 holes as Mike only trailed by 2 points. Ernie then took the final three holes to push up his point total up and take the match. Good effort to Mike and nice round Ernie.

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The final pairing was between Steve and Bob. Bob posted his second (54) in a row and starting to reduce his handicap. After the first 5 holes the match was deadlocked at 5 points each. The match remained tied as the players split hole #6. Then it was all Bob, nailing 2 pars in his last three holes to take the final 6 points and double Steve's total. Steve finished with a (56), 5 strokes better than his last round. Nice round to Bob.

There will be two more position rounds in the next three months.

Abe played a much better round this week than he did last week, knocking off 9 strokes from his round. Abe comes in with a (58). Holes 1 & 2 cost him 6 extra shots with back to back triples. A bogey on 3 was followed by back to back doubles. Hole number six and hole number 9 were by far the worse holes as he posted a double par on both. He took a double on #8. Good effort and round Abe.

A7: Nate Hood (46) / Terry Allen (54): We want to welcome newcomer Terry who is taking over for our injured brother Trevor. We continue to lift up Trev in our prayers for healing and comfort. Nate stuck a par between hole 1 & 3 draining a nice putt on the first par 5 as he comes into the 19th hole with a (46). He continued draining a par putt on #4 and then the bottom dropped out on 5 & 6. The holes cost Nate back to back triples costing him a lower 40's round. He recovered some posting a couple more bogeys and a par on #9. Nate finished with (3) pars. Good shooting Nate. Terry took a bogey on #1 and then got stung by a quad on #2.
