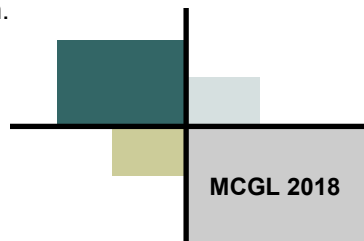
A9: Bill Gaunt (sub Caleb Gerschick-40) / Steve Ciaramitaro (sub Ben

TIPS FOR THE GAME

~~CHIPPING~~

Ball Position Is Critical

in chipping, ball position is very important. Did I say it's very important? Well, it really is!

The main focus in golf chipping is to strike the ball solidly. To do this, the ball must be placed (for me) just right of the right foot (or left of the left foot - if you are left-handed). I line the ball

up to my right little toe. This will give me solid contact. Now, all I have to do is find the line I must hit the ball on and do it.

Don't Blade It (Chipping)

Your left wrist (for right-handed players) should never move during the chipping process. If it does you will blade the ball.
