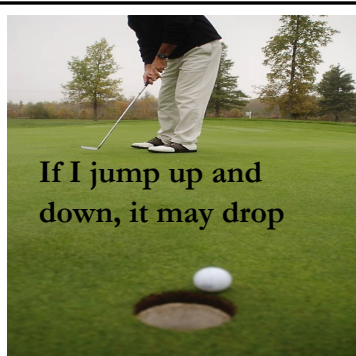
Team B2: Larry Ball /
