Team 1A: Wayne Davidson / Warren Hood

Our defending champions from last year got off to a slow start in week 1. Wayne shoots a (44) and Warren posts a (47). Wayne notched (5) pars in his round. Hole number 6 took a gouge out of his score card as he posted a double par on the hole. He followed that with a double on his very next hole. Still not a terrible round shooting a (44) for the first week of competition. Partner Warren was only able to post (1) par in a round riddled with mostly bogeys. He had two holes that did his round in. He put a double on the card for hole number 2. He took a triple on the 9th hole. Good try Pastor Warren.

Team 2A: Brian DeRita / Brent Cymbalski

Brian and Brent made a strong finish last year coming in 2nd place, falling short of taking first place by a couple of points. Both players came out firing in the first week of competition as Brent brought the course to its knees with a even par round of (36) and Brian comes in 4 over par round of (40). Brent was flawless through the first 6 holes, posting (2) birdies and (4) pars. The par 3 seventh and hole number eight hole bit him for bogeys. He finished with a par for his even par round. Brian started out slow, posting bogeys on his first three holes. Back to back pars before hole #6 slipped in a bogey. He finished with pars the rest of the way. Brian notches (5) pars. Nice shooting by both players.

Team 3A: Stan Dreslinski / Ray Ressler

Stan and Ray got off to a slow start in the season with both players shooting a bit over their current handicaps. Stan posted a (50) and Ray comes in with a (43). Stan was having some major back issues that helped to put a damper on his round. Stan's round was filled with 2 triples and 3 doubles to destroy his chance for a lower round. got off to a poor start as well with bogeys on the first three holes. He made back to back pars on 4 & 5 and then got bushwhacked by his favorite hole (NOT) #6. He took a triple. The only highlight of the round came on #7 where he stuck his tee shot within 10 " of the pin for nearly a hole in one. He made the putt with a left handed putter supplied by his opponent. Ray finished with back to back bogeys. Ray made (2) pars and (1) birdie.

Andre and Dennis both had their problems in the round as Andre posted a (44) and Dennis a (50). Andre played bogey golf from hole 1 thru hole #6. He nailed a par on 7 and 9 sticking in his only double of the round on #8. Andre finished with (2) pars. Dennis really struggled in his first week of play, with two holes beating down his round with triples. Those came on hole #3 and hole #6. Dennis nailed (1) par, that came on hole #9. The balance of the card was filled with a doubles and bogeys.

Bill and Kirk took enough points in week one to enter the standing sheet in a tie for 2nd place with Team A8 with 21 points. Bill got bit by 4 doubles in his round, posting them on holes 1, 3, 5 and 6. He notched pars on 3, 7 & 9. The worse hole turned out to be #8 that clipped his round with a triple. Bill finished with a (48) in the first round of competition. Kirk played a pretty steady round in his first week of competition. He put together (5) pars in his round. (4) holes did the most damage to his round costing him a much better round. He took doubles on three holes and got bit by a triple on hole #6. Kirk shoots a (45). All in all a nice round by Kirk.

Mike had a tough round to start the competition week, coming into the 19th hole with a (61). Mike card was riddled with 3 triples and 3 quads. Mike took triples on both par 5's and hole #8. The quads showed up on 1, 6 & 9. He posted bogeys on the two par threes and a double on hole #3. Tough round Mike, but good try. Dave likewise had a very tough round coming in with a (65). His first three holes dictated a very tough round. He took 6 extra strokes on hole #1 and was followed by a triple on #2. He added 5 more shots over the par on #3 and found a double on 4. Dave put back to back triples on 5 & 6 with a welcome bogey on 7. The final two holes added an additional 6 shots. Good try Dave.

Team B5: Walter Wnuk / Tom Regal

Walter posted triples on holes #1 & #3 sticking a double in between on the first par 5 as he came into the clubhouse with a (58). Hole #6 was as unkind to Denny as to many others as he took a triple. A double on #7 was followed by a bogey on 8 and par on 9. Good effort Denny. Partner Denny K came into the 19th hole with a (50). Denny put back to back bogeys on #1 & #2 before posting a double on #3. He got on a par run, posting three in a row, which included one on the tough #6 hole. The last three holes did the most damage to his round. Hole #7 cost him 5 extra shots and was followed up with back to back triples. A decent start to league play Denny K.
