A3: Stan Dreslinski (46) / Ray Ressler (42):

Stan continues his struggles to get his rounds back into the lower forties as he limps in with a (46). Some tightness in his back continues to plague his rounds. Three doubles crippled his round as he posted them on 10, 12 & 14. Stan nailed his only par of the round on hole #15. A valiant try Stan. Ray stayed in the low forties for the fourth straight week coming into the club-house with a (42). Ray was able to notch (3) pars, coming on both par threes and the par 5 - 18th. He put a single double on the card, coming on #10. The balance of his card was filled in with bogeys. Good round Ray.

A4: Dennis McQuade (sub Caleb Gerschick

(34) / Eric McQuade (41): It was the Caleb Gerschick show in last weeks round as he comes in with a great 1 under round of (34). His only blurb came on hole #11 that got him his only bogey. He nailed two birdies in his round coming on holes 15 and 17 which remove the one extra shot and kept his round under par. He nailed pars on all the other holes. Great shooting Caleb. Eric, who took over for Andre continues his fine shooting as well, coming into the 19th hole with a nice (41). Eric also notched (3) pars, his coming on 14, 15 and 17. Eric posted bogeys on the

on the other 6 holes. Very nice shooting Eric.

A5: Bill Marsack (51) / Kirk Cejmer (45): Bill was missing a driver and a putter and it seemed to take a bit out of his round. He won't admit it and said it was the player behind the clubs but without your own equipment you sometimes have a tougher time to perform. It showed with a round out of the 40's that hasn't happened since the last week of May, as he comes in with a (51). Three triples crippled his round as he added the extra 9 shots on 13, 14 & 17. He notched (1) par coming on hole #11. Couple of doubles and the rest of the card was filled in with bogeys. Good try Bill. Kirk also had a tough round as he comes into the club-house with a (45). Kirk nailed four pars in the round. Two triples and a double did the damage that made it hard for him to recover and post a lower forties round. Kirk made pars on 10, 13, 15 & 16. Good effort Kirk.

A6: Billy Alessandrini (48) / Scott Brogdon (44):

After three weeks of lower forties rounds, Billy stumbles a bit and for the second week in a row & stays in the upper 40's posting a (48) last week. Three doubles and a triple did the damage to his round. Hole 15 got him for a triple and he added the doubles on 10, 12 & 14. Good try Billy. Scott stayed in the lower quadrant of the forties as he

coasts into the watering hole with a decent round of (44). Back to back doubles did the damage to his round, coming on 16 & 17. Scott managed pars on 11 and 14. Bogeys filled in the balance of the holes. Nice round Scott.

A7: Ken Huyghe (40) / Abe Pomeroy (HC

55): Ken continues to play well and comes in with another nice round, posting a (40). Ken nailed a birdie on hole #13 to go with 3 pars in his round. Ken notched pars on 14, 16 & 17. Very nice round Ken. Abe was absent and a handicap scorecard was used to match up against his opponents card in week 12.

GOLF TIPS - PART TWO

4. To find the sweet spot on each of your golf clubs, you need to practice a lot until you manage to strike the golf ball right at the base of your swing's arc. You will feel a clear difference when you strike the ball in the sweet spot, and it will be noticeable in the distance of your shots as well.

5. Playing out of a sand trap is many a golfer's worst nightmare. The secret is to aim for the sand in front of the ball, to open the clubface and to go through with the shot. Many golfers stop with the shot as soon as the club makes contact with the sand. The idea is not to get distance, but to pop the ball up in the air and let it fall softly on the green.

6. Improving your score is always a priority in golf and the best way to achieve constant progress is to practice your short game as much as possible. **Practice your putting, chipping and pitching the MOST and you will experience lower scores on a regular basis.**

B1: Dale Lohr (47) / Shane Lohr (42):

Shane leads the B flight in with the best round of the night as he comes in with a very nice round of (42). His worse hole came on hole number 12, that cost him four extra shots.
