After a double on 4 Dale nailed back to back pars on 5 & 6. He added a double on 8 stuck between a bogey and a par. Dale finished with (6) pars. Very nice shooting Dale. Shane was absent but had sub Nate Kulbacki fill in for him last week. Nate posted (3) pars, tough hole #1, hole 3 and #7. His round included a triple on 8 and double on 5. Nate finished with a (45). Good round Nate.

B2: Norm Giraud (53) / Larry Ball (50): Norm has been hovering around the low fifties and comes in with a (53), three strokes higher than last week. Three triples did the damage to his round, posting them on 1, 6 & 8. Add three doubles and the round was pushed into the 50's. Norm notched a single par coming on the par three 7th. Good try Norm. Larry has been in the higher forties for the last few weeks, but went up three strokes putting his round at (50). Larry posted two pars, one on 3 and the other on 7. Five doubles and a tripled pushed his round up and out of the forties.

B3: Ernie Danos (48) / Steve Fleck (abs-HC 57): Steve was unable to make league night and a handicap card was used to post against his opponent. Ernie continues to shoot in the 40's coming into the watering hole with a (48). Ernie nailed a birdie on the first par 5. Other than a triple on #5 and two doubles, Ernie played a pretty decent round with bogeys on the balance of the round. Good shooting Ernie.

B4: Mike Alessi (abs-sub Paul McWhinnie (42) / Scott Graham (abs-sub Dave Maxon (47): Paul

continues to shoot well as a sub and posts a very nice (42). Paul nailed pars on holes 1 thru 4. Holes 6 and 9 clipped him for doubles and he added a couple of bogeys. He made a final par on 8. Nice round Paul. Dave Maxon comes in with a (47). Dave made two pars, coming on 6 and 8. He made two doubles and the balance were bogeys. Good try Dave.

GOLF TIPS CONTINUED

7. It is more accurate to align your feet to check your stance by placing a club across your heels and not your toes, as many golfers do. You will find that your heels are always in line, compared to your toes that often flare, which causes an inaccurate alignment.

8. On the tee box, always tee off with a club that you are more familiar with. Some golfers will hit a three wood because they feel it will be more accurate, but often the three wood is not a club that they hit as often as the driver. If this is you, stick with the driver.

9. Know your golf rules before you go out on the course. The water hazard rule can be tricky, so be certain that you know the difference between the lateral water hazard (red stakes) and the regular water hazard (yellow stakes).

Remember, use the tips, relax, play and have fun.
