A1: Wayne Davidson (39) / Warren Hood (44): Wayne finally broke into the 30's for the first time this season, coming in with a 4 over (39). Wayne played a steady round, nailing 5 pars along the way. Bogeys filled in the rest of his card. Great round Wayne. Warren played a decent round, posting a (44). Two holes did double damage to his round with back to back doubles on 14 & 15. He made his only two pars back to back on 17 & 18. Nice shooting Warren

A2: Brian DeRita (36) / Brent Cymbalski (35): Brian continues to shoot steady rounds in the thirties to low forties as he comes into the 19th hole with a one over par (36). Brian's card was filled in with two bogeys, a birdie on #14 and 6 pars. Very nice round Brian. Partner Brent outdid his Brian by a stroke, coming in with an even par round of (35). Brent posted a bogey on #10, a birdie on #15 and rest pars. Another great round again Brent. With a 36

point lead in the division, the Boy's of Summer pretty much lock up 1st place in the 2019 season.

A3: Ray Ressler (43) / Stan Dreslinski (47): Ray turned it around after last weeks disappointing round knocking off three strokes to post a (43). Ray got stung by back to back doubles on 10 & 11. He leveled out after that notching 3 pars and 4 bogeys. Good effort Ray. Stan had two holes dictate his (47) going up 6 strokes from last weeks round. The 10th hole cost him a double, but #11 bit him for a triple. He notched a single par, coming on #15. He posted bogeys on the rest of his round. A valiant effort Stan.

A4: Dennis McQuade (46) / Eric McQuade (41): Dennis dropped three strokes off last weeks round coming into the watering hole with a (46). Holes number 13 and 14 took their toll on his round. He took a double on 13 but got stung by a quad on #14. Dennis nailed back

to back pars on 16 & 17, posting bogeys on the rest of his round. Good try Dennis. Eric got back into the lower 40's dropping four strokes off last weeks round. Eric comes into the clubhouse with a very nice (41). Eric nailed three pars, one on 12, one on 13 and the final one on 18. He nailed a birdie on 15 but got bit by doubles on 10 & 17. A5: Bill Marsack (43) / Kirk Cejmer (40): Bill continues to shoot in the lower 40's for the last four weeks, coming into the 19th hole with a (43). Bill nailed pars on 10, 15 & 18. Back to back doubles on 13 & 14 kept him from possibly dropping into the thirties. Bogeys filled in the balance of the card. Nice shooting Bill. Kirk rebounded from last weeks round, dropping off 6 shots to post a very nice 5 over round of (40). Kirk nailed a birdie on #13. He added pars on 11, 16 & 18. A double bogey cropped up on #15 to go with four bogeys. Very nice round Kirk.

A6: Billy Alessandrini (45) / Scott Brogdon (47): Billy dropped off 6 strokes from last weeks round as he comes in with a (45). Billy nailed back to back pars on 12 & 13. Three doubles did the damage that kept his round in the middle of the forties. He doubled, 10, 14 & 18. Good try Billy. Scott was able to come down only 1 stroke from last weeks round, posting a disappointing (47). Scott's round was riddled with five doubles that did his round in. He got bit on 10 & 11, added doubles on 13, 17 & 18. Scott posted par on #12 & #15. Good effort and try Scott.

A7: Ken Huyghe (39) / Abe Pomeroy (54): Ken got back into the 30's after a week hitting a round in the forties. Ken put a (39) on the card in week 18. Ken nailed a birdies on #11 and #15. He put pars on the card on 13 & 16. He added a lone double on #14. Nice round Ken.

After a couple of lower forties rounds the last few weeks, Shane struggled coming in with a mid forties round of (46). Shane nailed a lone par on hole #13.
