**Team 06: Larry Ball (49) / Norm Giraud (57):** Larry is starting to stay in the forties as he comes in with a (49), two shots higher than last week. Three holes took the most toll on his round. Both par 5's nipped him with doubles. The hole that took most of the wind out of his sails was #8 that cost him four extra shots to finish the hole. Larry posted his only par on the 9th hole. Still a decent round Larry. Good effort. Norm's round continue to climb up instead of going down. Norm came in with a (57) this week, one stroke higher than last week. Opening doubles on 1 & 2 pretty much set the stages for a high round. The third hole knocked him back further with a triple. He salvaged a bogey on #4 before the 2nd par 5 added another double. Hole six turned into a huge disaster as he added a quad. The final three holes added up to an additional 8 strokes with a quad on #8 surrounded by double on #7 & #9. A valiant effort Norm.



**Team #07: Steve Mitchell (57) / Kyle Kapa (62):** Steve had a few more problems this week going up 5 strokes from two weeks ago, limping in with a (57). The #1 handicap hole got him for an opening double. He posted a bogey *continued top right*



on the par 5 - 2nd and then the 3rd hole clipped him for a quad. Back to back doubles plagued his round even more as he posted them on #4 & #5. The tough #6 only cost him a bogey, but then the next three holes did the balance of damage to his round. He finished with a double, triple and quad. Good try Steve. Kyle likewise had some major trouble in his round too, as he went up 5 strokes from his previous round coming in with a (62). The first two holes bushwhacked his round as he posted 5 extra shots on both holes. The double seemed like a relief until #4 cost him a triple. He bogeyed the par 5 - 5th and then #6 gouged him for a quad. He nailed a par on #7 and then finished with a double and quad. A valiant effort Kyle.



**Team #08: Adam Grewe (56) / James Allen (49):** Adam was absent for two weeks and went up four strokes from his previous round on 6/3. Two holes, #1 and #4 really beat up his round costing him 11 extra strokes just for those two holes. He nailed his only par on #5. He started pretty fair, posting a bogey on the 1st hole and nailing a par on the first par 5. He continued to play well, nailing a birdie on #3. He surrounded the triple on #7 between doubles on #6 & #8. He finished his round with a bogey on #9. Good try James.



**Team #09: Bill Marsack (46) / Kirk Cejmer (46):** Bill dropped off a stroke from last week coming in with a (46). Bill stuck in a par on #2 between doubles on #1 & *continued top right pane*

#3. He bogeyed his way to #5 and then got bit by a double. He made a decent recovery with back to back pars on #7 & 8 before finishing with a double on #9. Good round Bill. Kirk also came into the clubhouse with a (46). Kirk posted an opening bogey and then proceeded to notch back to back to back pars taking him to #5, where he put a bogey on the card. Hole #6 started the downfall to his round with a triple. A bogey on #7 and the final two holes took him for back to back doubles keeping his round in the mid forties instead of the lower forties. Still a good round Kirk. Bill and Kirk have company at the top as Team #04 (Brent & Andre) are in a tie with them for first.

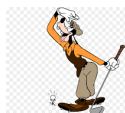

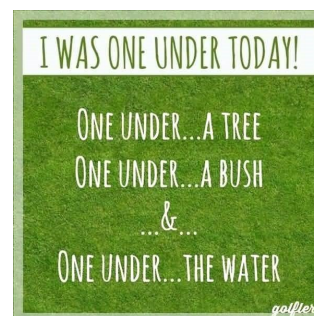


card. He finished with a bogey on #8 and par on hole #9. Very nice shooting Wayne.
