Team #13: Mike Littleton (42) / Sub Gary Kwapik (40):

Mike continues his fine playing and comes into the watering hole with another nice round, posting a (42). Mike posted bogeys on holes 1, 2 & 3 and then proceeded to notch back to back pars on 4 & 5. Hole #6 clipped him for a double, but with the birdie on #7 he was able to make one of the extra on 6 disappear. He missed his chance to get into the 30's with his second double, this on #9. He did nail one more par on number 8 to keep a low round. Nice round Mike. With Justin back in school, Gary Kwapik filled in for him and comes in with a very nice (40). Gary had the same kind of bogey trouble that his partner did, starting on 1 and 2. Gary got hot and nailed three straight pars, taking him to #6 where he too took a double. He finished strong, nailing a birdie on #7 and a par on #9. Nice shooting Gary.

Team #14: Ernie Danos (57) / Steve Fleck (57): Well it wasn't a good week for both Ernie & Steve as they both struggled in their rounds. Ernie showed up in the clubhouse with a (57), his worse round of the season. The first three holes pretty much dictated a high round, as he posted two triples and a quad, costing him 10 extra shots right from the start of his round. After a couple bogeys on 4 & 5, Ernie made his second quad. He bogeyed 7 and then took back to back doubles to end a tough round. A valiant effort Ernie. Steve had just as much trouble as his partner as he

opened with a triple and then back to back doubles. After a bogey on 4, Steve took another double, followed by a quad on #6. He finished his last three holes with doubles and a round of (57). A good effort and try Steve.

Team #2: Walter Wnuk (46) / Ray Ressler

(42): For the third time in the second half, Walter posts a nice (46), knocking 6 strokes off last weeks round. Walter made a great shot on #1, to land about 12 feet from the pin, to nail one of his two pars. He jumped on the bogey train from hole #2 through hole #6, where he got off to nail his second par. Holes #8 nipped him for a double with the 9th hole doing the rest of the damage with a triple. A very good round WW. Ray continues to play some decent rounds, and comes into the 19th hole with a (42). Ray bogeyed the first and second hole and then posted his only double of the round on #3. He nailed a par on #4 and then bogeyed the 2nd par 5. He recovered well, posting pars on 3 of his last four holes to make it a nice round. Good shooting Ray.

Team #3: Wayne Davidson (46) / Warren Hood (46):

For the second week in a row, both partners shoot the same score. Wayne had his fair share of problems, posting a double on #1. He bogeyed his way to number 4 where it took his round down three extra strokes, posting a triple. After a par on #5, Wayne got stung by another double. He notched a very nice birdie on #7, sticking it within 43 inches to take the closest to the pin for the year with the shot. He finished with back to back bogeys for his round of (46). Warren likewise came in with a (46). He stuck a bogey on #2 between doubles on 1 and 3. He put a double on the card for #4, and then bogeyed his way to #7, where he nailed a par. He bogeyed #8 and finished with a par on #9. Good effort Warren. Warren and Wayne are a mere 4 points out of first. Good try Warren.

Team #4: Brent Cymbalski (39) / Andre Viger (37):

Brent and Andre continue to post some very nice rounds. Brent was on a roll from #1 to #4, posting pars on the holes. He got bit by back to back bogeys on 5 & 6 before resuming pars, that he notched on hole #7 an #8. He finished his under forties round with a bogey on #9, to shoot (39). Andre posts the best round of the night for the league with a very nice 1 over par (37). After a bogey on #1, Andre put it together nicely. He nailed his first of two birdies on the par 5 second. He par his way to hole number 7, there he notched his second birdie. The final two holes cost him a chance to par the round, or even go one under as he posted back to back bogeys. Great round Andre. Andre and Brent are 2 points out of first.

He made bogey on the #1 handicap hole #1 and then went double -double on his next two holes. He put back to back bogeys on 4 & 5 before the 6th hole gouged him for a quad. He bogeyed 7, parred 8 and finished with a triple on #9. Good round Larry. Norm comes into the clubhouse with a (54). Norm faired pretty well on the #1 handicap hole, putting a bogey on the card. The first par 5 got him for a double, and the 3rd

nailed his first of two pars on the par 5 - 2nd. Things went a bit south from that point, as he got stung by a double on #3. He bogeyed #4 and then holes #5 & #6 clipped him for a double and quad. He nailed his final par on #7 and finished up with back to back doubles. Good try James. Adam dropped 6 strokes off his round from last week, coming into the clubhouse with a 52. Adam got bit by a triple on #1 and followed that up with a double on the par 5 - 2nd. He bogeyed 3 and nailed his only par on #4. A bogey on #5 was followed with a double on #6. 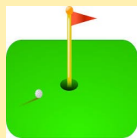
