A8 (DAN D'AMATO & NATE HOOD) SHARE THE TOP SPOT WITH A1 (JOHN GREWE & DAN WICKER) AFTER TWO WEEKS OF COMPETITION!!

Team #A1: Dan Wicker (38)/John Grewe (40): Dan dropped off two more strokes from his first weeks round coming in with the best round of both flights shooting a two over round of (38). The first par three on the front clipped him for a double, he made one more bogey coming on the final hole. He nailed a birdie on hole #7, missing a hole in one by only eight inches. Great round Dan. John dropped off three strokes from last week coming in with a very nice round of (40). John was on a par roll for the first five holes with pinpoint accuracy to get on the green and some very nice putts to notch pars. He strung together bogeys on the final four holes to post a nice round.

Team #A2: Andre Viger (41)/Trevor Vallus (43): Andre continues to play decently coming into the clubhouse with his second (41) in a row. Andre played steady throughout his round. He got bit by an opening bogey and

then put together three pars in a row. The last four holes did the rest of the damage to his round with bogeys on holes 6 to 9. Still a nice round Andre. Trevor rebounded from last weeks tough round, dropping off 10 strokes to come into the 19th hole with a (43). He played bogey golf most of the round. He nailed pars on holes #1, #3 and #7. Other than the double on #9, he bogeyed the balance of the holes in his round. Good shooting Trevor.

Team #A3: Bill Marsack (44)/Kirk Cejmer (47): Bill knocked three strokes off his round from last week coming into the clubhouse with a nice round of (44). Bill got bit by a couple of doubles. The first one on hole #2 and the second one on tough hole #6. He was able to reduce the overage of his round by one, nailing a birdie on hole #7. He posted a lone par on hole #4. Good shooting Bill. Kirk still struggling a bit

to get back to his game from last year. He knocks off three strokes from last weeks round a he comes in with a (47). Four doubles cripple his round for the most part. He nailed a birdie on number 4 but added a triple on hole #8. Still an admirable try Kirk.

Team #A4: Warren Hood (44)/Wayne Davidson (46): Both players had better round in week 3. Warren dropped off 3 strokes from last week as he comes in with a (44). Warren nailed pars on both par 5's along with one on #3. Hole #6 did the most damage to his round as he got stung by a triple. The balance of his card was filled in with bogeys. Good round Warren. Wayne comes into the clubhouse with a round of (46), dropping off a couple of strokes from last week. The two holes that cost him a much better round were hole *continued below left*

#6 that he put a triple on the card and hole #9 that cost him a double. Wayne nailed pars on both par three's to help his round. Good effort and round Wayne.

Team #A5: Ray Ressler (41)/Walter Wnuk (55): Ray was able to knock off a couple of strokes from last weeks round posting a nice round of (41). After an opening bogey on #1, Ray parred the next four holes. His next four holes all led to bogeys to keep him from posting a better round. All in all, a decent round Ray. Walter continues to struggle some, coming into the watering hole with a (55), a stroke higher than last week. Walter had double trouble on most of

the holes in his round. One hole clipped him for a triple. He posted a lone bogey on #3 but the other 7 holes did the double damage to his round. Good effort and try Walter.

Team #A6: Billy Alessandrini (47)/Rick Berschbach (55): Billy had a little trouble this week coming in three shots worse than last week as he limped in with a (47). Hole number one took his round down immediately as he got bit by a triple. He notched his only par on hole #2. He then proceeded to put bogeys on the card for the next 7 holes before the 9th hole cost him a double to hurt his round more.

Good effort and try Billy. Rick had a lot more troubles this week, adding 6 extra strokes on his last weeks round. Rick finished his round with a (55). Rick's round was riddled with doubles on every hole except two. He got a lone bogey on #3 but disaster struck on hole #8 that cost him a quad. It was just one of the rounds that you really want to forget and go forward. I expect a much better round from Rick this coming



Team #A7: Chad Woolman (42)/Mike Rainish (abs-HC44): Chad continues to play well, and posts a (42), a stroke higher than last week, but staying consistent with his shooting. Chad made a par to start his round on the long hole #1. He posted bogeys on the first par 5 hole #2 and then another bogey on #4. He parred #3 and nailed a birdie on #5 to drop off one of the bogeys. Chad got bit by double bogeys on #6 and #8. He nailed the par on #7 and finished his round with a bogey on #9. Good round Chad. Mike was absent and a handicap scorecard of (44) was used against his opponent.

Team #A8: Nate Hood (42)/Dan D'Amato (43): So far Nate is playing very consistent golf, posting his second (42) round in a row. He started slow, posting an opening double on

hole #1. After a bogey on the first par five, Nate notched pars on the next three holes before tough number 6 beat him up for a double. He finished with a couple of pars, one on #7 and the other on #9, sticking a bogey in between. Nice round Nate. Dan added a couple of strokes to his round from last week, coming into the clubhouse with a (43). Chad had some troubles out of the gate, posting a double on #1 and #3 with a bogey in between on #3. After settling down Dan notched a par on #4 and birdie on #5. He would add one more par on #7, but two more doubles that put more of a dent on his round. Holes number 6 and 9 did the double damage and cost him a much better round. Still a decent round Dan.

Team #B1: Mike Marihugh (49)/Angel Woodruff (54): Both Mike and Angel dropped three strokes off their last weeks rounds. Mike comes in with a (49) getting his round back into the 40's. Four holes did the most damage to his round. He got stuck with doubles on holes #3, #5 and #8. Hole number six did the most damage as he got stung by a triple. He posted his only par on #9. Good effort and try Mike. Angel also reduced last weeks round by 3 as he comes in with a 54. His first three holes cost him the most extra strokes in his round. He opened with a triple on 1 and followed that up with a double on hole #2 and quad on #3. He settled down some,

putting a bogey on the card on #4 and a very nice par on #5. Hole number six got him for a triple and he finished with a bogey on #7 and back to back doubles on #8 & #9. Good effort Angel.

Team #B2: Dave Benson (44)/Mike Alessi (62): Dave shared second best round honors coming in with a (44). After opening with a bogey on #1, Dave took back to back doubles on the first par 5-hole #2 and hole #3. He leveled out a bit posting back to back pars on #4 and the hole #5. Like many others, hole #6 wasn't kind to his round as he put a double on the card. He

finished with a par on #8 surrounded by bogeys on #7 & #9. Still a nice round Dave. Mike continues to struggle in his rounds coming in a stroke higher than last week as he posted a (62). Mike's round started out rough with a quad on #1 and it didn't get any easier as the round progressed. He added three triples in a row, starting on #2 and stopping them on #4. After a double on #5, the bottom caved in again with a quad on #6. He added one more triple and back to back doubles to finish his round. A valiant effort and try Mike.

Team #B3: Ernie Danos (48)/Steve Fleck (abs-HC 54): Ernie came in a couple of strokes better than last week, posting a (48). Ernie opened with back to back doubles on the #1 handicap hole on the front and the first par 5, hole #2. He then put back to back bogeys on the card on the 3rd and 4th holes. One more double, this coming on the second par 5 before Ernie leveled out his round with bogeys the rest of his round. Good try Ernie. Steve Fleck is out of town and a handicap card was used to post against his opponent.

Team #B4: Doug Busam (52)/Mark Blair (61): Both players had some troubles in their rounds in week two as both went up strokes in their rounds from last week. Doug comes in with a (52), six strokes higher than last week. Doug had triple trouble on two of his first three holes. He tripled #1 and #3, sticking in a bogey on the first par 5, hole #2. He put it together for two hole nailing back to back pars on #4 & #5. Then his round went south again, putting a double on the card on #6 a bogey on #7 and then back to back triples on #8 & #9. Good effort Doug. Marc likewise had trouble but he only went

up 2 strokes from last week. The first three holes pretty much dictated a high round as Marc opened hole #1 with five extra strokes. It wasn't any easier either as he added a double on #2 and quad on #3. He went double bogeys on 4 & 5 before #6 sunk his round down even more with a second quad. The final par three got him for a triple but he finished with a nice par on hole #9. Good try Marc.

Team #B5: Jim Turner (44)/Jim Vance (abs-HC 58): Jim Vance was absent and a handicap card was used to match up against his opponent. Jim Turner shared *continued below left*

second best round honors in week two, coming in with a (44). Jim started with a bogey on the first hole and followed that with a double on hole #2. He bogeyed his way to hole number 5 where he drained a putt to put a birdie on the card. Like so many others, hole number six clipped him for a double. He finished with bogeys on 7 & 8 and parred his final hole on #9. Good shooting and round Jim.

Team #B6: Mike Kove (51)/Rand Hewitt (59): Mike went up a couple of strokes in week 2 coming into the 19th hole with a (51). His first three holes did the most damage to his round. He put a double on the card on #1 and #2 and then got bit by a triple on #3. He stuck

in a par on #5, sandwiched between doubles on #4 and #6. He bogeyed 7 and 8 and finished with a double on #9. Good effort and try Mike. Rand knocked off two strokes from last weeks round as he comes into the clubhouse with a (59). The first two holes cost him 9 extra strokes right off the bat. He bogeyed #3 and then added back to back doubles on #3 & 4. After hole number 6 gouged him for a triple, Rand finished off his round with doubles on the final three holes. Good try Rand.

Team #B7: Dennis Wnuk (50)/Chris Offer (55): Dennis comes into the watering hole with his second (50) round in a row. The first hole started his round on a down-

ward note, posting an opening triple. He bogeyed the first par five but then got stung by a double on hole #3. He parred #4 and then things went south again. He took a double on #5 and triple on #6. He parred #7 but things didn't get much better. He finished with a double on 8 and bogey on 9. Good effort and try Dennis. Chris knocked off 7 strokes from last weeks round coming in with a (55). Holes one and two cost him back to back triples. He nailed two pars in his round. One on #3 and the other on hole #6. He added a triple on #4 and a quad on #8. He finished with a double on 7 and double on 9. Good shooting Chris.

Team #B8: Chad Nelson (43)/Jeff Schultz (49): Chad continues to play well and even through he went up a couple of strokes, he is still maintaining low forties rounds. Chad took an opening double on #1 and added back to back bogeys on 2 & 3. He nailed his first of 3 pars on #4. Three more bogeys taking him to the final two holes where he nailed back to back pars. Chad finished with a nice (43), leading the B flight players in with the best round of the night. Good round and shooting Chad. Jeff went up a few strokes as well, coming into the clubhouse with a (49). Jeff got bit by an opening quad on hole #1. He posted his first of four pars on the first par 5, hole #2. Hole number 3 cost him a double but he made up some ground with back to back pars on #4 & 5. Hole number six was not very kind to his round as it cost him a triple and followed that up with back to back doubles. He finished off his round with a closing par on number 9. All in all a decent round Jeff. Good shooting.
