Billy limped into the clubhouse with a (49). Three holes did the most damage to his round. It started with #10, that took him four extra shots to put the ball into the hole. Then #14 clipped him

for another three strokes leaving good old #17 costing him two more extra strokes. Billy finished with a par on #18 to end on a positive note. Good try Billy.
