Team #A7: Mike Rainish (43) / Chad Woolman (40): Like many others, hole # 10 took its toll on Mike's round costing him an opening double right from the start. Mike comes in with a (43) for the second straight week. A quick recovery with back to back pars on #11 & #12 before #13 cost him his second double. He would add pars on #15 & #18. Hole #17 clipped his round for his third double. Good round even with the extra strokes Mike. Chad continues his mastery of the course, coming into the clubhouse with a nice (40), sharing best round honors in the 'A' Flight in week 10. Chad nailed pars on four of his first 5 holes. Posting them on holes number 10, 12, 13 & 14. He put bogeys on the card on #11, #15 & #18. He got stung by his only double on #17. Very nice shooting Chad. Mike and Chad are only 3 points out of first now taking 24 points last week.

Team A8: Nate Hood (47) / Dan D'Amato (43): Nate had double trouble right from the opening tee off, getting bit with back to back doubles on #10 & #11. Nate went up a stroke from his typical rounds of 46 as he comes in with a (47) last week. Nate nailed a par on #12 and bogeyed #13. He added two more doubles to his card, coming on #14 and #17. He parred #15 and ended his round with a bogey on #18. Decent round Nate, good effort and try. Dan rebound from a upper forties round last week, coming into the watering hole with a (43), four strokes better than last week. After an opening bogey, Dan nailed three straight pars. Things went a bit south from then on. He got bit by doubles on #14, # 17 & #18. He added bogeys on the other two holes. Good round even with the hick-ups on three holes.

Team #A1: Dan Wicker (41) / John Grewe (41): Dan played very steady the first four holes, nailing pars on #10 & #11, then throwing in a bogey on the first par three, #12. He nailed one more par, coming on hole #13 and then got on the bogey train for the rest of the round. He started the bogeys on #14 and closed out his round with the final bogey on the par 5 - 18th. Dan finished with a nice round even so with a (41). Nice round Dan. John's rounds have been a bit of a roller coaster year, coming in with a mid forties round of (46). John parred #10 and then nothing went right. He bogeyed #11 and then it was 4 straight doubles taking him to #16. He nailed back to back pars on #16 & #17 and finished with a double on the final hole #18. Good try John.

Andre was on roll to start his round, posting pars on #10 through #13. Hole #14 clipped him for his first of two doubles. He bogeyed #15 and then nailed his 5th par on #16. Hole #17 cost him a final double and he finished with a bogey on the par five 18th. Good round Andre. Trevor dropped off 6 strokes from last week, coming into the clubhouse with a (41) like his partner. Trevor doubled #10 to start the round and then put a par on the card on

#11 and nailed a very nice birdie on #12. After a bogey on #13, Trevor nailed a par on tough number 14. Trevor put his second double on the card on #15 and then posted his final par on the card on #16. Trevor finished his round with back to back bogeys on #17 and #18. 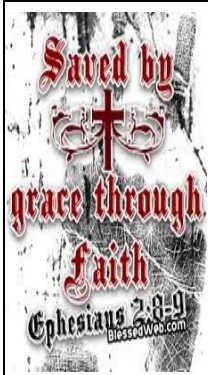
