

TEAM #B7 (DENNIS WNUK & CHRIS OFFER) REMAIN 20 POINTS AHEAD OF TEAM #B4 (DOUG BUSAM & MARC BLAIR) WITH TEAM #B5 (JIM TURNER & JIM VANCE) A MERE 5 POINTS OUT OF 2ND PLACE!!!

Team #B8: Jeff Schultz (52) / Chad Nelson (48)!! Jeff had a tough start to his round, posting a double on #1 and then getting clipped with a quad on #2. He leveled out some with back to back bogeys on #3 & #4 with back to back bogeys. Trouble popped up again on #5 with a double and #6 bit him for a quad. After nailing a par on #7, the final two holes took the rest of the toll on his round as he finished with his second quad, this on #8 and a double on his last hole. Jeff posted a (52).
