Team #2: Dave Benson (43) / Josh LeBlanc (48):

Dave started good, posting an opening par on hole #1. But hole number 2 took him an extra shot costing him a bogey. He added back to back pars before the second par 5 did him in with a bogey again. He nailed a par on #6 and finished with a par on #9, but added an extra stroke on the par three and a double on #8. Dave came in with a (43). Nice shooting Dave. Josh had taken over for Mike Alessi due to some health issues that Mike is experiencing. Josh started with an opening double, but staved off a double on #2. Unfortunately, #3 came back and got him for the double. He nailed a par on #4 and

He finished with a bogey on #9 but a great round Kirk!! Bill started out decently with back to back pars on #1 and #2. He bogeyed #3 and then nailed his third par on #4. Hole #5 sent his round reeling with a triple and then #6 beat him up for a double.
