Team A1: John Grewe (43) / Dan Wicker (40): John seems to be starting to get some of his game back as he comes into the clubhouse with a decent round of (43), a stroke better than last week. The first two holes bit into his round with back to back doubles. After a bogey on #12, John nailed back to back pars on #13 & #14. He added one more par on #16 and posted bogeys on the #15, #17 and #18. Good round John. Dan continues to shoot well and comes in with a nice (40) last week. Dan opened with back to back pars before the first par three nipped him for a bogey. After an par on #13, hole #14 clipped him for a double. He parred #15 and #18, sticking in bogeys on #16 & #17. Very nice shooting Dan.

Team #A2: Ray Ressler (41) / Andre Viger (38): Ray got off to a rough start, posting a bogey on #10 and then adding a double on #11. He recovered nicely posting pars on his next three holes. He posted bogeys on #15, #16 and #17 and finished on a positive note with a par on his hole #18. Ray finished with a nice round of (41). Good shooting Ray. Andre led all 'A' flight players into the 19th hole with a 3 over par (38). Andre knocked off two strokes from last week. Andre got off to a slow start posting bogeys on his first three holes. Mike came into the clubhouse with an uncharacteristic (47) last week. Like his partner David, Mike took a triple bogey on hole number 10. He bogeyed his way to hole number 13, where he posted his first of three pars.
